CIRCULAR TO CREDITORS & CONTRIBUTORIES
CONNECTED PROPERTY SERVICES PTY LTD (IN LIQUIDATION)
ACN 672 079 444 (“THE COMPANY”)

I refer to the appointment of:

- John Park and I, Joanne Dunn, as Joint and Several Administrators of the Company on 3 November 2025 (“Former Administrators”); and
- Stephen Earel of Cor Cordis as Liquidator of the Company on 4 December 2025 by order of the Supreme Court of Queensland pursuant to section 459A of the *Corporations Act 2001 (Cth)* (“Liquidator”).

Following the appointment of the Liquidator, the voluntary administration of the Company ended on 4 December 2025.

As you are aware, the Former Administrators convened the second meeting of creditors of the Company to be held on 8 December 2025. Once the Supreme Court of Queensland made orders to wind up the Company, the second meeting of creditors could not proceed and the Former Administrators were unable to seek approval from the Company’s creditors for their remuneration and disbursements incurred in the conduct of the voluntary administration. Accordingly, I intend to make an application to the Supreme Court of Queensland seeking a determination of the Former Administrators’ remuneration.

In accordance with rule 9.2(2) of the *Supreme Court of Queensland Act 1991 Uniform Civil Procedures Rules 1999*, a Form 16 must be served to relevant creditors and shareholders 21 days before filing the originating application.

The applicable Form 16 (**attached**), along with a copy of the draft originating process and signed affidavit on which the Former Administrators intend to rely are available for download from the FTI Consulting Creditor Portal website at the following address:

Creditors and contributories have until Thursday, 9 April 2026 to serve the Former Administrators with any notice of objection stating the grounds of objection to the remuneration claimed and any notice of appearance.

Once the 21 days have passed, the Former Administrators intend to file the originating process and affidavit along with any forthcoming objections with the Supreme Court of Queensland.
