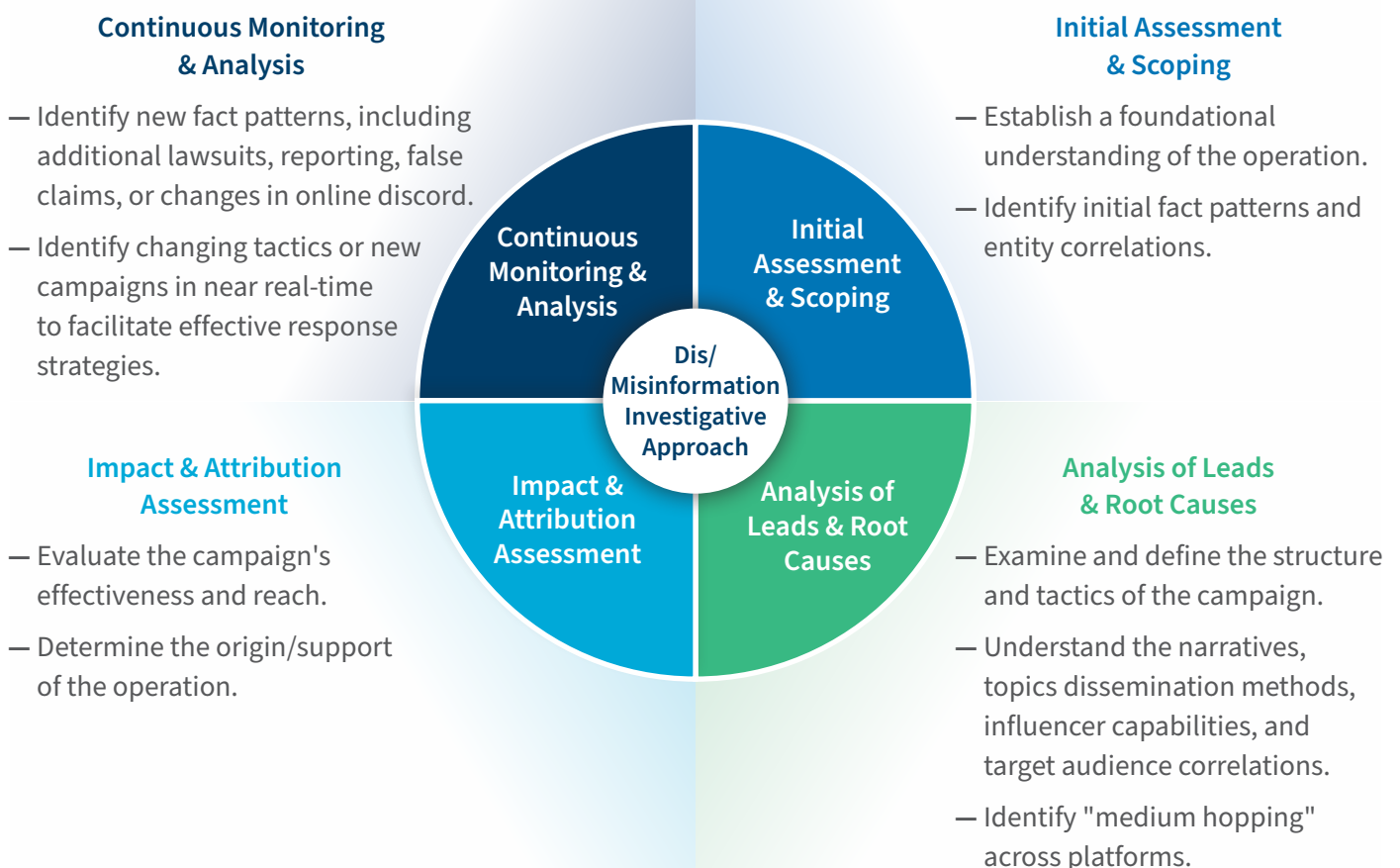


Disinformation & Misinformation Campaigns

Mitigation

To be crisis-ready and responsive, everyone must know their roles and responsibilities in advance. In addition, risk mapping and education can help clients understand their digital presence and evaluate communications methods to assess their susceptibility to coordinated dis/misinformation efforts.

Once an incident is identified, we combine the resources and tools necessary to determine the scope, impact, and appropriate response. These efforts determine the source of the incident and preserve necessary forensic artifacts. Then, our team moves into the containment, eradication, and recovery phase. Through a post-incident assessment, we detail the cost, cause, and response for the incident, along with steps that should be taken to prevent future incidents.

CASE STUDY

DISINFORMATION CAMPAIGN INVESTIGATION FOR A HIGH-PROFILE INDIVIDUAL

FTI Cybersecurity was engaged, through outside counsel, by a high-profile individual who was concerned that they were undergoing a targeted online disinformation campaign following the release of the client's product. Online sentiment appeared to have shifted negatively, and the client was seeking investigation into whether there was any coordination behind the activity.

OUR IMPACT

Our effort resulted in a conclusive final report, which included specific online accounts and posts that were at the center of the disinformation campaign and trend analysis that demonstrated the genesis and overall arch of the campaign.

A critical result of FTI Cybersecurity's investigation included multiple online personas acknowledging that they were paid to post the negative content that was then amplified to go viral.

OUR ROLE

Our investigation teams focused on a sentiment analysis to identify un-natural inflection points in online discord about the topic and the client; open-source intelligence gathering to identify specific individual accounts, across multiple online platforms, and posts that originated the shift in sentiment; and forensic analysis to preserve content across multiple user devices for ties to the disinformation campaign.



CASE STUDY

ONLINE REVIEW INVESTIGATION FOR A GLOBAL TELECOMMUNICATION SOLUTIONS PROVIDER

FTI Cybersecurity was engaged, through external counsel, to investigate a corporate rival's fraudulent manipulation of their online reviews.

OUR IMPACT

We uncovered email communications, invoices, PayPal payments, expense reports, and subpoenaed technical data, including IPs, domain names, email addresses, and usernames, from review websites that tied the defendant to the fake review scheme. Relying on our findings, damages experts calculated damages north of \$40 million, which persuaded the opposing side to settle.

OUR ROLE

Our team analyzed documents, obtained through discovery, and conducted significant open source intelligence gathering while developing a repeatable methodology to identify fake reviews with varying confidence levels as proof of the fraudulent scheme. We provided our findings in an expert report and deposition.
